

**Regular Town Board Meeting
Town of Del Norte, Colorado
February 12, 2020**

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Del Norte, Rio Grande County, State of Colorado, met in regular session on February 12, 2020 in the Board Meeting Room, 140 Spruce Street, Del Norte, Colorado at the hour of 7:00 p.m. There being present at the CALL OF THE ROLL the following persons:

ROLL CALL:

Town Board present: Trustee Bob Muncy, Trustee Brenton Williams, Trustee Tony Dinger, Trustee Gary Sabrowski, Trustee Laura Anzalone, and Mayor Chris Trujillo with Mayor Pro tem Sam Scavo absent. Mayor declared a quorum present.

MINUTES:

Trustee Gary Sabrowski made the motion to approve the Regular Board minutes for January 8, 2020 and January 8, 2020 Public Hearing Meeting, Trustee Brenton Williams seconded the motion. Roll call vote: All Ayes, Mayor Trujillo declared motion carried.

CITIZENS COMMENTS:

Tammy Haynie 770 Spruce Street-Approached the Board to say a few words on behalf of Interim Chief of Police Frank Archuleta.

CONSENT AGENDA

Kevin submitted his written report and was not present as he was attending the Colorado Rural Water Conference in Denver. Sergeant Archuleta gave the Police report and mentioned that he will be re-vamping the monthly police report. He feels it doesn't give a full picture of what they do, it will have more detail of calls and contacts. Motion was made and seconded to approve the consent agenda. Roll call all ayes, Mayor Chris Trujillo declared motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Chris Trujillo presented Interim Chief of Police Frank Archuleta will the Valor Life saving award. Frank helped rescue Christine Gallegos from her home on January 29th, her home was on fire and he was the first on the scene and pulled her out of the home until the fire department could arrive. Members of the Del Norte Fire department also commented on the fire that it could have turned out differently if he would not have arrived when he did. Children of Christine Gallegos, Debbie Hickman and Tom Gallegos were very appreciative of the efforts that Frank put in pulling their mother out of the home, and endangering his life for hers.

Del Norte Riverfront Project-Marty Asplin gave the Board an update of the project, stated that the play wave is done, and the construction crew will be back to finish the eastside of the pier. And this summer the pavilion on the north side of the river will be going in.

Adrienne Atencio-HVCC-approached the Board to ask if they would be a grantee of the community development block grant, she would like to expanded the building. Mayor Trujillo mentioned that the building could not be enlarged until she goes through the process of going through the Board of Adjustments to ask for a variance. Mayor Trujillo also mentioned that applying for grant that is due on the 18th of February three day away and wanting the Town to be a grantee of the grant and wanting the Town Board to approve it would not happen. We haven't even seen any paperwork of the grant, or even the cost of the proposed budget, the layout and more importantly no paperwork was submitted.

Attorney Report

Attorney Farish mentioned that we will be holding off on the soccer field property until the County decides if they want to relinquish it to us or the school.

Town signs-Auction, sell or give way-It was the consensus of the Town Board to put an ad and flyer in the paper and water billing asking for sealed bids.
