

**Regular Town Board Meeting
Town of Del Norte, Colorado
March 11, 2020**

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Del Norte, Rio Grande County, State of Colorado, met in regular session on March 11, 2020 in the Board Meeting Room, 140 Spruce Street, Del Norte, Colorado at the hour of 7:00 p.m. There being present at the CALL OF THE ROLL the following persons:

ROLL CALL:

Town Board present: Trustee Brenton Williams, Trustee Tony Dinger, Trustee Gary Sabrowski, Trustee Laura Anzalone, Mayor Pro tem Sam Scavo, Trustee Bob Muncy and Mayor Chris Trujillo absent. Mayor Pro tem declared a quorum present.

MINUTES:

Trustee Gary Sabrowski made the motion to approve the Regular Board minutes for February 12, 2020 and Trustee Tony Dinger seconded the motion. Roll call vote: All Ayes, Mayor Pro Sam Scavo declared motion carried.

CITIZENS COMMENTS:

CONSENT AGENDA

Sergeant Archuleta gave the Police report and introduced Brendan Picheon to the Town Board; Chief read his bio and wanted to let the board to let them know that he has been with the department since November. He also wanted to let them know that he got a call and missed some of the presentation of the bolo wrap that RG Sheriff Office was holding. Administrator Martinez did attend and it was similar to the tazer, but this discharges a tether towards the target and entangles and restrains the individual it wraps the tether like wrap when triggered. Motion was made Trustee Laura Anzalone to purchase two of the bolo wraps for the department; motion was seconded by Trustee Brenton Williams. Roll call: All yes, Mayor declared motion carried. Kevin gave his report and wanted to let the Board know that due to state mandates on sewer test it is going to cost quarterly in the amount of \$4000/\$16000 a year for this particular test. Motion was made by Mayor Protem Sam Scavo to change the budget amount for testing that is required, seconded by Trustee Gary Sabrowski. Roll call: All yes, Mayor declared motion carried. Motion was made and seconded to approve the consent agenda. Roll call all ayes, Mayor Chris Trujillo declared motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Valley Wide Health Services-MAT Program-Kristina Daniels gave a presentation on Medication Assistance Treatment it's a combination of counseling and behavioral therapies through the individuals medical provider. The approved medications include Methadone, Suboxone, and Vivitrol. These medications ease the symptoms of opioid use disorder. These services are provided through SLV Behavior Health which Del Norte does have an office here in Town. They are currently working on their website and the web address is SLVMAT.ORG for anyone that might want to use their services. They are also working on flyers through their marketing team. Town Board thanked Kristina for attending.

Attorney Report

Attorney Farish mentioned that we will be holding off on the soccer field property until the County decides if they want to relinquish it to us or the school. But that a resolution was never done on the Del Norte School subdivision when it was approved last year. Motion was made by Trustee Gary Sabrowski to approve Resolution 3-2020; seconded by Mayor Protem Sam Scavo. Roll call: All yes, Mayor declared motion carried.

Town signs-Administrator Martinez mentioned that she had received the cost for the Town signs, they are more than expected. We did put in the budget from last year \$30k, if we wanted to proceed with the signs we will need to increase the amount to add another \$60k and that could be taken out of capital improvement fund. Motion was made by Trustee Laura Anzalone to take the additional monies out of the capital improvement fund, seconded Trustee Brenton Williams. Roll call: All yes, Mayor declared motion carried.

CML scholarship recipient is our own Trustee Laura Anzalone she will be attending the CML conference in June and her registration and room will be covered through the scholarship. Congratulation Trustee Anzalone.

Kehr and Company, LLC brought in the liquor renewal today and it was a renewal. Motion was made and seconded to approve the liquor renewal for Kehr and Company, LLC. Roll call: All ayes, Mayor declared motion carried.

Trustee Williams asked about leasing one of the storage bins at the DN Coop. It was consensus of the Board to allow a lease agreement with Trustee Williams for his business.
