Statement of Purpose of Hearing

Mayor Burnett stated that the purpose of the Hearing was to present Ordinance No.763 Adopting Rules and Regulations as Guidelines for designating site selection and construction of Major New Domestic Water Systems and Municipal and Industrial Water Projects as Activities of State Interest

Opening Statements

Mayor Burnett introduced as Hearing Officer Gene Farish. The hearing Officer introduced the pertinent information regarding Ordinance No. 763 and explained the procedure for conduct of the Public Hearing. Hearing Officer Farish mentioned to the Town Board that is a two-procedure process and it started with Ordinance No. 756. An Ordinance Designating Site Selection and Construction of Major New Domestic Water Systems and Major Existing Domestic Water Systems and Municipal and Industrial Water Projects as Activities of State Interest. And this Ordinance No. 763 is adopting rules and regulations as guidelines for designating site selection.
